

PASTOR'S NOTE

Dear Saints.

This coming Wednesday is your day! November 1st is the Solemnity of All Saints, and it's worth remembering what it means to be a saint so we can live out the call even more fully.

To start, there is no such thing as a cookie-cutter saint. Like the rest of God's creation - whether in the sky or on the earth or under the sea - diversity is on full display when you look at the lives


