10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

____Have I been grateful to God for what I have?

____Have I wasted my time wanting things I do not need?

____Have I thanked God for His countless blessings, and treated my possessions with care and respect (e.g. keeping my room neat, my clothes, my books, tools and appliances, my classroom, desk, toys, games, bicycle, etc.)?

____Do I willingly share with others?

____Have I wished for and/or pressured my parents to purchase things which I do not really need?

The Great Commandment: "Love others, as I have loved you" (John 15:12).

____Have I done my best to love everyone in my family? my friends? my enemies? strangers?

____Is there anyone I have not loved the way Jesus wants me to love?

____Have I forgiven others as I ask Jesus to forgive my sins?

Steps to a Good Confession:

Be brief, be brutal, be absolved!

- 1. Carefully examine your conscience.
- 2. Be sincerely sorry for your sins.
- 3. Make a firm resolution not to sin again and avoid the near occasion of sin.
- 4. Confess all your sins in the confessional and receive absolution.
 - 5. Do the penance the priest gives you.

Suggested Dialogue:

Priest: May the Lord be on your heart, on your mind, and lips so that you may know your sins, confess them with them with true repentance and a firm purpose of amendment.

Penitent: Bless me father, for I have sinned. It has been ______ since my last confession.

Here state your sins.

Priest gives counsel and penance.

Penitent: (Act of Contrition)

Oh my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee and I detest all my sins, not only because I fear the loss of heaven and the pains of hell, but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, Who art so good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to confess my sins, to do penance and to amend my life. Amen.

Listen absolution and respond "Thanks be to God."
