Making a Worthy Confession

- 1. Approach the priest, whether in the confessional or in the main church.
- 2. Make the sign of the cross and say:

I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin."

- 4. Father (in the Person of Christ) will absolve you from your sins.
- 5. After making the sign of the cross, complete your penance.
